### New repeat prescribing policy

All GP practices in Bradford are now adopting a new initiative recommended by the CCG where pharmacies are no longer able to order repeat prescriptions on your behalf

This is in order to promote understanding about taking your medicines and taking ownership of re-ordering, with a hope this will reduce medicine wastage.

Please note that any patients who are vulnerable and may need additional support will still be able to reorder their repeat prescriptions (either from the practice or from the community pharmacy).

We can arrange free TB screening for you




#### **Patient Online Access**

#### Gluten-free foods

NHS Bradford City CCG has recently carried out a public consultation into prescribing gluten-free (GF) foods for patients diagnosed with coeliac disease, and have decided to stop this prescribing for patients of all ages.

GF products are widely available from all supermarkets and are sold to the public at prices that are considerably lower than the NHS is charged when bought for use on prescription.

- Every day in the UK 9 women are diagnosed with cervical cancer
- •3 women lose their lives from the cervical cancer every day
- •Cervical cancer is their most common cancer in women aged 35
- •75% of cervical cancers are prevented by cervical screening (smear tests). Unfortunately 1 in 4 women do not attend this potentially life-saving test
